GUEST RIDER POLICY AP 560 (OCTOBER 2022)

To ensure the safety of our students on their bus rides at the end of the day, Chinook School transportation updated the process of a student becoming a guest rider in October 2022.

For example, if Lucy needs to ride on her friend Jane's bus, Lucy's parents would contact Jane's parents to make sure this will work out for their family.

Both parents need to contact Mrs. Adams at the school to notify her of this change.

**We also appreciate families letting teachers know if their child is traveling on a different bus at the end of the day, as has been practiced in the past.

Mrs. Adams, then will call the bus driver, (instead of the parents contacting their bus driver), to make sure there is adequate space on the bus for a guest rider.

Two guest riders are allowed per situation. In the event that it is a family needing guest ridership up to 4 would be allowed because they are siblings. An example might be if parents were away and their family of 4 needed to be dropped off at another rider's house for childcare during the week they are away.

Please notify the school before 2:00 p.m. if your child requires guest bus ride services. Please note that the bus can only stop at their regularly scheduled stops.

Student Information - Within LAFOIP
(Local Authority Freedom of Information
And Protection Privacy Act), the school

following ways:

- Once a record is received by the school division, the record can be used and shared within the school division without consent of the parent or student for the purpose for which the information was obtained and for a use that is consistent with that original purpose.
- Only persons requiring access to the records to perform the duties of their employment are allowed to access and use the records based on the need-to-know principle. The record may be placed within the student's cumulative file.
